
Member CRITIQUE

Town of Gilbert

The Sit In, a public art project created by the Town of Gilbert Arts, Culture and Tourism Board (ACT) is recruiting artists and sponsors.

"This project is a fun and functional form of public art," said Diane Fales, ACT Board Chairman. "People can gather around the art for fun photos or just sit and relax! Unlike the iconic public art animals or symbols, we selected a bench in the style of an over-stuffed chair to represent Gilbert as a comfortable community."

The project received Council approval June 6. The ACT Board hopes to have artists and sponsors in place to begin production this summer with anticipated installation of the benches in the fall. Public events to view the artists' work in progress will be scheduled during the production time.

"The success of *The Sit In* public art project starts with artist and sponsorship interest," explained Fales. "The cost to sponsor a bench is minimal for the extensive exposure opportunities over two years." For artists, the benches provide an exciting new venue for expression. They will also receive a stipend for their work."

The cost to sponsor a bench varies from \$2850 to \$5000.

Initial focus for the bench placement is the Gilbert Heritage District. Locations for the benches will be posted on the Town's new Heritage District app as well as the Town's tourism website. Sponsors will be able to select an artist to paint their bench from a portfolio and be recognized with a plaque on the bench, as well as the unlimited social media opportunities.


