Dave Flitner is leading our critique for October 4th

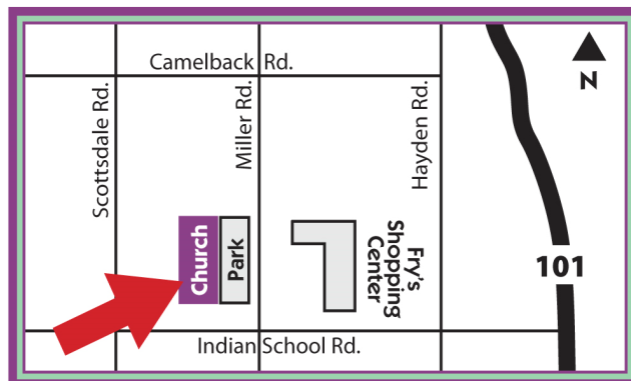

I want to thank everyone for their interest and support in the changes to the **Chad's Show** which will be held during the next General Meeting on October 4th here at Scottsdale United Methodist Church, in lieu of the Artist of the Month. Artwork must be brought to the meeting room between 5:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. Only one piece of art per artist and please, no extra large artwork as space is limited. There is no entry fee. First, second, third place ribbons and three honorable mentions will be awarded. Only members who are current with their dues and attendance will be eligible to participate. The judges for the show are; Heather Kirk, Raul Espinoza and Patty Rosky and the alternate judge is Eva Maria Ciolina. I know these judges will honor their responsibility with integrity and fairness.

Regarding the **ASU Gammage Theatre Show**, Brad Myers asked that we try to keep the theme holiday-ish, no summer landscapes please. **Jurying for this show** will be at Scottsdale United Methodist Church during the **November 1st General Meeting between 5:30 pm – 6:30 pm.** All active artists in good standing may enter up to three paintings. Jury fees will be \$10.00 for one painting, \$20.00 for two paintings and \$25.00 for three paintings. 45 paintings will be juried for the show. The minimum size for artwork is 16 x 20 or larger. All artwork must hang on the walls, no freestanding art is allowed. All artwork must be ready to hang with two screw eyes or two D-ring hangers with wire in place, suitable to be hung. **This must be accomplished by juried date or your work will not be juried.** Installation of the art is scheduled for Wednesday, November 30th 2011 beginning at 9:00 a.m. and must be completed by 3:00 p.m. of that same day. 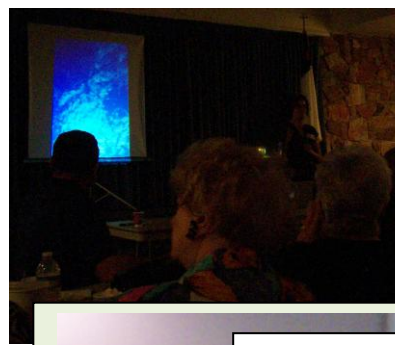
