Member CRITIQUE

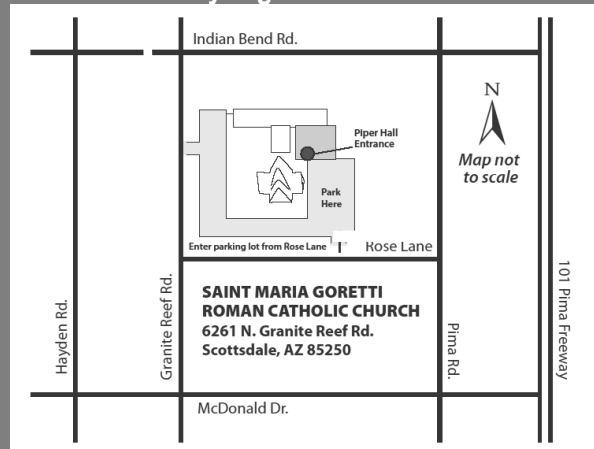

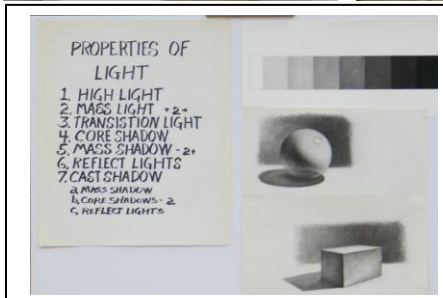

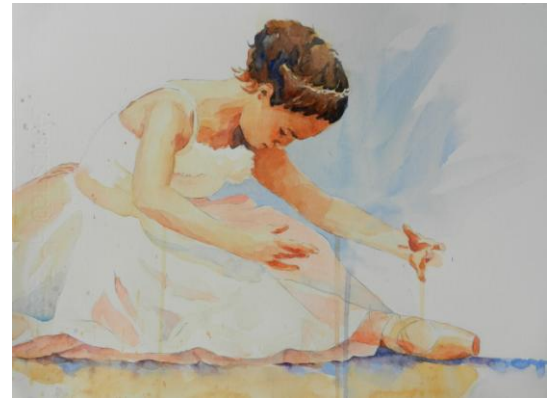
Andrea started out painting in oil. She loves the patinas and glazes you can create with thin layers of color upon color. Oils take a lot of patience and time and although she still paints in oil, she was looking for something new to add to her art experience. She recently took a series of watercolor classes from some amazing teachers at the Scottsdale Artists' School. They opened up a whole new world to her with this wonderful medium. Through different teachers and different techniques, Andrea has learned to create her own style of watercolor painting that is exciting her viewers and supporters.

**For marketing purposes, we have assigned a theme for each exhibition, but do not let that deter you from entering any art piece you wish to show (in the categories in which you are juried).*

What's in it for me?

Reasons to exhibit at the Arizona Art Alliance Fine Art Gallery:

1. Out of Pocket: \$25/panel/month plus **FREE** space in the AZ Alliance Artist Gift Shop (lower price point but generates great sales, artwork does not have to be your juried medium).
2. 30% of sales go to “tax-exempt contribution” to the Alliance (helps to keep the gallery doors open) in both the main gallery and gift shop—NOT 50-60% commission at other galleries!
3. Volunteer only 7 hours per month, per panel to support your gallery (can be accomplished in two 3.5-hour AM or PM sessions, or one 7-hour day). You pick the day (s) you want to volunteer. Check with those volunteering in your area to carpool. **Day and time is Your choice!**
4. Guaranteed networking opportunities. Build rapport with other artists, supporters of the arts, and fine art buyers. You want to engage, laugh a little and have fun than you will love this place.
5. Give yourself time to work on your art. Demonstrate your art techniques while working on an art project during your volunteer hours. Seize the opportunity for impromptu critiques from other respected artists or share you artistic knowledge with others.
6. Like to talk art? Promote and Sell your art on display at the gallery run by volunteers. Now is your opportunity to see and show the community the benefits from volunteerism.
7. FREE learning or enhancing experience in hands-on art selling, creative viewing of artwork by local artists, and nationally known and published artists, while promoting other community support venues. Learn more about current art exhibits or opportunities.
8. Expand your imagination exploring other forms of art. Over 3000 local artists in every “fine art” media – all exhibited at the AZ Art Alliance Gallery; not specialized as with other galleries. Indulge yourself in the how’s, why’s, and what’s of art appreciation.
9. Grow your leagues membership. Promote and Recruit new members to YOUR league/guild by inviting visiting artists to your next meeting. This has proven to be very successful with a number of art leagues.
10. 7 hours of relaxed “work” time/environment, with the specific day’s “chores” taking all of a few minutes to perform, seems to be an easy “price” to pay, for all the benefits gained. Just ask those of us that have experienced it. Stay Healthy in Mind and Spirit, Volunteer.

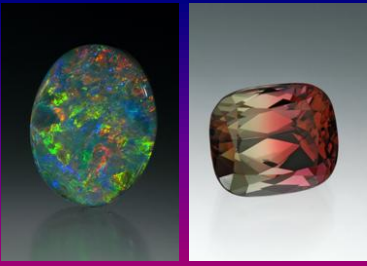
