

Editor's Note: Marsha Lazar Klinger (Publicity) is filling in for Barbarann temporarily.

Desert Botanical Garden – SAL will meet with the staff to negotiate terms of a contract to satisfy both parties once Barbarann Mainzer returns. SAL will put down a deposit to exclusively reserve the area we used last April 2016.

Butterfly Wonderland – Due to the opening of the Odysea Aquarium, the administration wants to re-schedule the “Black Friday Show” until sometime after the New Year. They are expecting 1.5 million people on Thanksgiving Weekend and are afraid of clogging the area where we normally set up. This is a crossing area between venues.

Westminster Village – IT IS IMPORTANT TO BRING THE PUBLIC TO THIS SHOW!

We want your finest work. We are waiving the 3 meeting rule and have changed the duration of the show to two months. The fee for the first art piece will be \$15, two pieces will be \$20 and limit of three pieces remains \$25. Bring your artwork to WMV Monday, September 26 between 10:00am and Noon. Bring the Hold Harmless Form filled out and a check with the entry fee amount made out to SAL or exact cash. If your work sells you will be donating 20% to the WMV Foundation; it is tax-deductible and 10% comes back to SAL. To those artists who do not do outdoor shows this is the perfect venue. It is indoors and lasts only 2 months.

Drop off time for the next Scottsdale Artists League, Westminster Village Show and Sale will be held on Monday, September 26th, 2016, from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. You will be notified if you need to pickup non-accepted work from 3:00 to 4:00 pm. Artists who are in the current show are asked to pick up their artwork on that day from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. If you cannot pickup on that day, please call: Margaret Licosati at 602-751-1603, or email to painter@licosati.com, previous to that day. For details, Hold Harmless forms and Show Prospectus are attached at the end of the newsletter.

Because the space is huge there is no size restriction. The pieces need to be framed correctly or gallery wrapped. Two dimensional works must be either D-rings or screw eyes with wire. No sawteeth hangers will be accepted.





The Art Beat received this letter from Hal Stewart. Hopefully many of you members can add additional 'Call to Artist' information in future editions. Thanks, Hal, we will be adding to your list.

I am a bronze sculptor and have shown in many shows and exhibitions across the USA. I've had exhibitions in museums, I've taught, and served as Artist In Residence for two National Parks.

Thinking about Scottsdale Artist League, I realized that some of our artists do not know how or where to enter competitions other than the local art shows. Like you, I started showing in local art shows (AAG). Then I wanted to show in more shows. By hunting and poking around, I found some sites with Calls For Artists.

Below are a few websites to find competitions, both locally, nationally, and international:

callforentry.org I use this site often. Entries for local shows, public art work, private art work, museums, and galleries. Sign up and receive updated show announcements regularly.

zapplication.org Almost the same as above but with a few different entries.

National Park Service Go to their website and look under Artists In Residence Programs in the parks. Don't be too shy to apply for these programs – be positive, they need you.

City of Scottsdale This is just an example. Many cities including Phoenix, Glendale, and Chandler have websites devoted to public artwork. Search any city in the USA you want to visit. Get involved, attend artists meetings, and submit your work.

Along the way I've learned a few things; you must beat your own drums and toot your own horn to get attention and get noticed. You should NEVER assume your work is not good enough for any show or organization. Think positively. ALWAYS assume that you will be successful in whatever endeavor you undertake in the art world, believe they will pick you. There is a market for everyone's work, regardless of how new or how old you are to the art world.

I hope this has been helpful in finding new shows. Now get out there and enter as many shows as you want. Good Luck.



*Take down of previous show September 26, 2016 between the hours of 10AM to 12PM. If that small window of time is inconvenient, you can take down your artwork early if Show Committee is advised first. Contact Lynn Thornburn 602-999-3514 (alouette@cox.net) or Margaret Licosati 602-751-1603 (painter@licosati.com).

Judging for the Westminster Village Show will be Monday, September 26, 2016 at Westminster Village, 12000 N 90th Street, Scottsdale, AZ 85260. Drop-off of artwork is between 10AM to Noon. Pick-up of non-accepted artwork 3PM to 4PM. (DIRECTIONS: Cactus Road going east pass over the 101, turn right at 90th Street. Then take the first right and drive through the main gate. Go to the cul-de-sac, staying to the right and pull up to the glass accordion doors to unload and sign in. Take artwork(s) to NUERNBERH Hall, located just south of the reception desk – if needed, ask receptionist for help.

Artist may submit up to three (3) pieces of art for the entry fee of \$15.00 for one, \$20.00 for two or \$25.00 for three. Checks make payable to the Scottsdale Artists League and bring entry fee along with artwork to be juried. No participation fee refunds will be given. There will be no 3 meeting requirement but you must be current on your membership dues. All artwork must be 2-D and 3-D to be juried. All artwork must hang on the walls or rest on pedestals. Artwork must be ready to hang with two screw eyes or two D-rings with wire in place suitable to hang. Gallery wrapped canvas' are acceptable but must be finished on all sides. Only original artwork works will be accepted, no giclees. Substitutions of artwork or price changes will not be permitted after the jurying is completed. All artwork must be for sale, SAL will not accept any artwork that was sold before the show. Donation will be 20% for a Foundation associated with the Westminster Village and is tax exempt so if your artworks sells be sure to collect documentation. 10% will go to the Scottsdale Artists League Scholarship Fund with the remaining 70% being for the Artist.

The length of the shows at Westminster Village will be two (2) months and be an on-going event. Hopefully we would like in the future to have 2 – 3 Artists Shows along with the SAL. This show will end Monday, November 27, 2016. Pick-up time will be 10AM to 12 PM.
