

ODYSEA IN THE DESERT

PROSPECTUS for original art, prints and sculpture (no jewelry)

9500 E. Via de Ventura, Scottsdale

Display and sale date are February 2, 2019

- Artists must deliver and display their own artwork on Sat., Feb. 2, from 7am to 9am with the show and sale hours being 9am – 4pm. Artists will remain for the duration of the show until take down at 4pm. Artists are responsible for picking up their own art work. The displays are in the sunny open air courtyard. There is lots of space, so participants with white 10 x 10 tents and their own display panels are encouraged. **In case of inclement weather, white tents may be necessary.** Unloading will be done at Lot 4 entrance (see attached map). Unloading of materials may be done on Friday evening and storage will be provided by OdySea. Park elsewhere in the lot after unloading.
- Entrance fee for 10 x 10 tent with display (provided by the artist) is \$50.00. **OR** Entrance fee for using SAL provided panels is \$25.00 for each type of display. SAL panels are 34" wide by 50" tall **or** 3) 3-D pieces **or** 3 linear feet of table space. You may pay for more than one type of space, (i.e. one panel and one table= \$50.00). All work on panels should be original. **Prints may be sold from slings or other appropriate containers** (provided by the artist). All hanging work must have screw eyes or d-rings with picture wire. No saw tooth hangers. No exceptions. All work must be family friendly (no nudes, etc.) All work should be labeled with an SAL provided title card on back and a card for identification on the panel. **Please have these made out in advance.**
- The 3 meeting requirement will be in effect. New members excepted.
- SAL supplied inventory sheets must be used and complete. **Please have these filled out in advance.**

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- Each participant is encouraged to be actively engaged in the production of artwork at their respective space. The advertising states that **active creation of art work** will be happening. Unlike true plein aire painting, painting or creating from photos is acceptable. Each artist is encouraged to have some sea or butterfly themed work available for sale. Each participant is expected to **be in attendance at their display** during the sale hours. Please wear your SAL name tag.
- There will be a separate sales station and place for packaging purchases. If a piece is sold, the artist must bring it to the sales station and package it after the receipt is completed. **Each participant will be expected to work at the sales station for a short period of time.** All sales will be through the SAL account and appropriate taxes will be charged.
- Sale contributions are: 20% to OdySea Aquarium Charitable Foundation, 10% SAL and 70% to the artist.
