

# Desert Botanical Garden “Paint Out”

**Dates are Saturdays: March 7, 14, and 28, and Sunday: March 22, 2020**

**Time is from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm.**

**The Desert Botanical garden has given the Scottsdale Artist league very stringent guidelines of what they expect from us. Anyone that doesn't abide will be asked to leave.**

- The Desert Botanical Garden expects all of the artists, to be courteous to all Garden guests and staff at all times.
- Paintout member's art should be freestanding and you are not to block any passageway or set up in the garden beds or lean anything against any walls or benches. Stay on the cemented walkways.
- Do not dump any liquid, including ice or water, in the plant beds or leave any trash behind. Please bring a bag for your trash and bring it home to be disposed.
- You may bring a small cooler, if you keep it hidden, because food and coolers are not allowed in the garden. Lunch must be eaten at the café areas. You can bring lunch with you.
- You may only bring in one easel, one chair and your painting supplies. You may use one 4 x 4 table and you may use a wagon. You can display art on this wagon and hold restock inside if covered, or if you are using a table, you may hold restock under your table. Tables need to use a black tablecloth that will cover to the pavement. You may go to your vehicle if you need to restock. No sales in the parking lot. All art must be listed on your inventory sheet and be turned into Robin at the end of each day along with receipt books, any checks and cash.
- You may display 3 sellable paintings and be working on a fourth.
- All artists need to be painting on the piece that is displayed on the easel. You may wish to begin a few paintings ahead to be completed at the garden.
- The entrance staff will have a list of the 30 artist that will be attending for each date. No family members will be allowed in free of charge.
- **You must wear the Scottsdale Artist League Shirt, that will be made available and wear your name badge. No exceptions.**
- You must park in the main parking areas only. The back gate is locked.
- There will be no weekend art fair in April.
- The three meeting rule will be strictly enforced.
- Interaction with Garden patrons should be low key.
- **No small items will be shown, no jewelry, magnets, this is strictly an art showing.**
