

WESTMINSTER VILLAGE SHOW PROSPECTUS

Oct. 17, 2020 through Jan. 4, 2021

Take down of existing show will be Oct. 17 between the hours of 10AM and noon. If that window of time is inconvenient, you could ask a friend to pick up your work.

Intake of new artworks will be at the same time, Monday Oct 17. The Village is located at 12000 N. 90th Street, Scottsdale, Az 85260. Drop off your work **at the main entrance**. All works meeting hanging requirements will be accepted.

Artists may submit up to five (5) pieces for entry fees of \$10 for one or 2, \$15 for 3, \$20 for 4 and \$25 for 5. Checks should be made payable to Scottsdale Artists League. Bring your hold harmless and entry fee at time of submission. No participation refunds will be given. **You must be current in your membership dues. Artwork must be either original work, dry point, etching, monotype, limited edition print, or giclee. No other form of copies will be accepted.** Artwork can be 2-D or 3-D. All hanging works must have screw eyes or D-rings with picture wire in place suitable for hanging. Gallery wrapped canvas are acceptable, but must be finished on all sides. **No 3-D pedestal based works will be accepted at this time.**

All artwork must be for sale, SAL will not accept any work that was sold before the show. Donation will be 20% for a Foundation associated with Westminster Village and is tax exempt so if your artwork is sold, be sure to collect documentation. 10% will go to Scottsdale Artists League Scholarship Fund with the remaining 70% being for the artist.

Due to the Covid 19 restrictions all art works will be handled by WMV staff. The existing pieces will be on carts in the main entrance and new works will be left there as well. The show will be hung by WMV staff. It is the hope of WMV and SAL that this can be a continuing venue after restrictions are lifted.

This show will end on Jan 4, 2021. Pick up time will be from 10AM to noon, with the next show submissions occurring at the same time. We hope that all health restrictions will be lifted by then and that we can return to our standard procedure.

All sales transactions will be handled internally by SAL and when sold, the artwork will be removed by staff and saved for the buyer. The artist will be notified and arrangements made to replace the sold piece. All entries are made at the risk of the entrant. Neither SAL nor WMV may be held liable for damage to any entry while in the possession of Westminster Village. Care and caution will be made in the handling of all artworks. All Hold Harmless forms **MUST** be signed by entrant.

There will be NO reception for this show, again due to Covid 19 restrictions.
